Serge Morand is senior researcher of the French CNRS and researcher at CIRAD (Centre International de Recherche Agronomique pour le Développement). He is Adjunct Professor at the Faculty of Veterinary technology, Kasetsart University, and invited Professor at the Faculty of Tropical Medicine, Mahidol University. Due to his expertise in biodiversity and health, Serge Morand has been invited to more than 40 international lectures, seminars or key note lectures, and has co-organized 20 regional and international workshops and symposiums over the last ten years. Major achievements include the development of a research domain in health ecology, by linking environment, land use land cover changes, biodiversity and the evolutionary ecology and epidemiology of zoonotic diseases, or antimicrobial resistance at the frontiers of human health, animal health and conservation biology (One Health/EcoHealth) in Southeast Asia.
